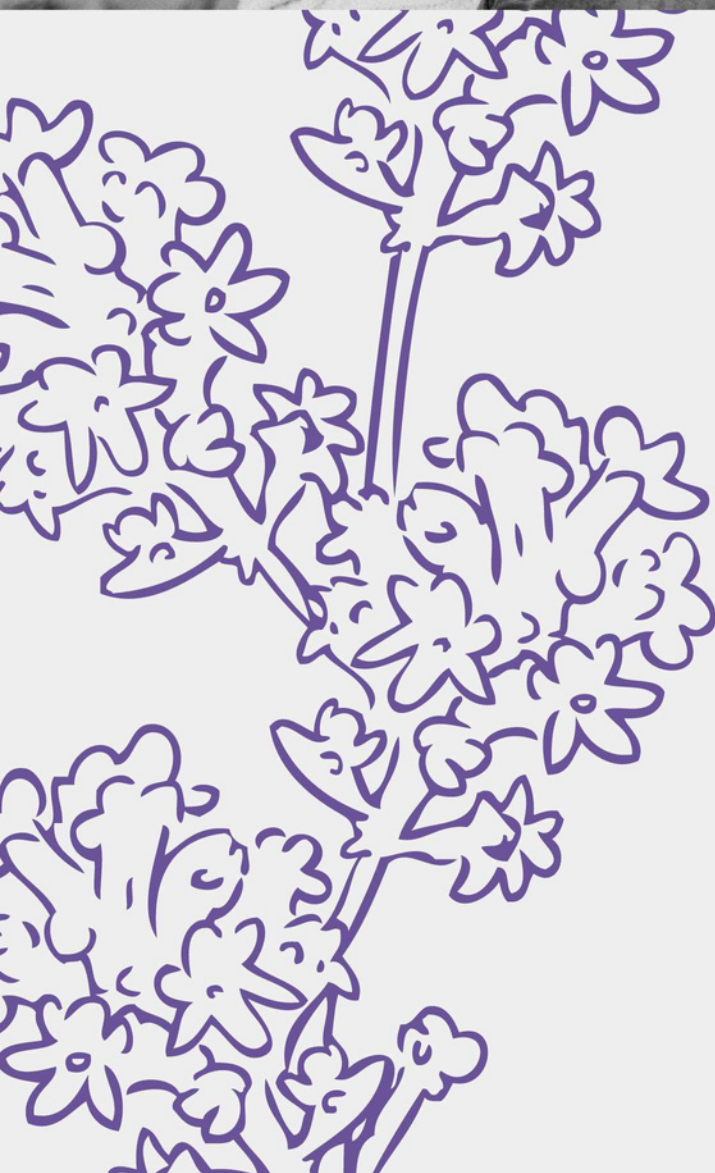

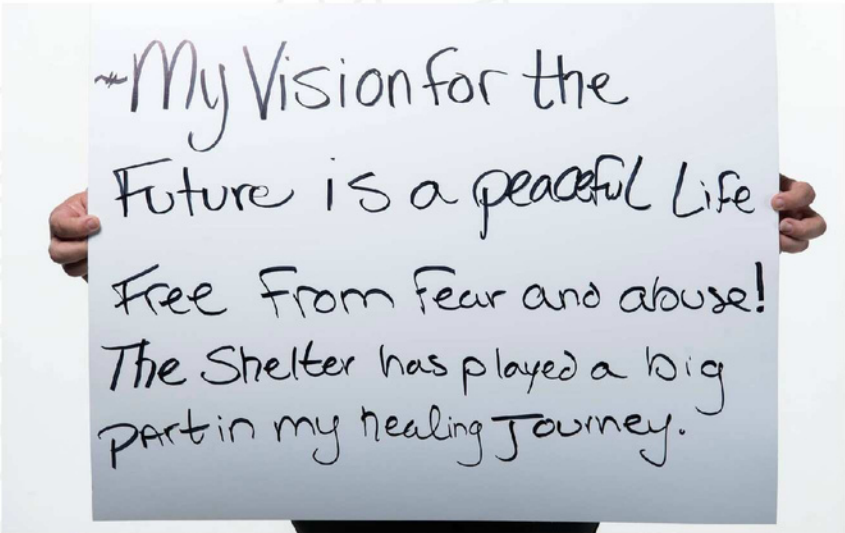


OUR YEAR IN REVIEW

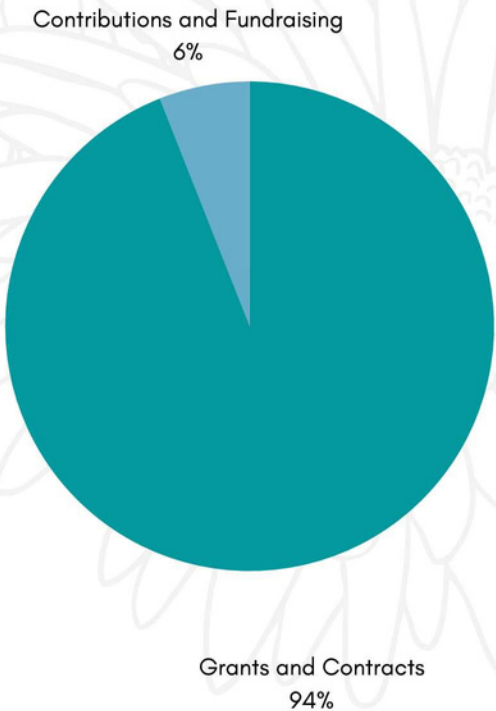
- Provided emergency shelter services to 170 local victims
- Responded to 773 24/7 hotline calls and chats
- Provided 245 counseling sessions
- Served 13,647 meals
- Provided services to 109 clients at our walk-in advocacy centers
- Provided 196 transports
- Assisted over 100 clients with a no-cost attorney
- Expanded our court services to include McGirt and Mental Health Dockets



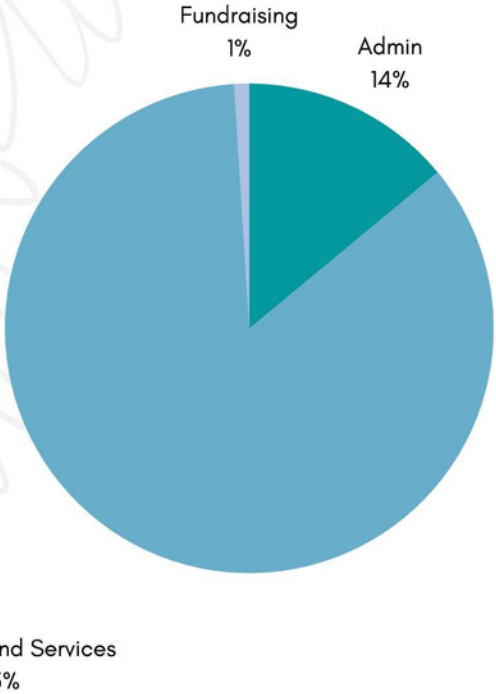
